PRESS RELEASE

The Prime Minister has established Special fund for victims of terrorism in the name of "Prime Minister's Special Fund for Victims of Terrorism" for providing relief and shelter to the displaced persons of the current conflict in Swat and its adjoining areas.

The Consulate General has designated Mr. Mohammad Nasrullah Khan, Vice Consul (Welfare-I) and Mr. Jehangier Mushtaq, Vice Consul (Welfare-II) for the collection of the funds cheques/cash in connection with the Prime Minister's Special Funds for the Victims of Terrorism. In addition to the cash donations, countries/agencies may consider donations of the following items which will be of great help in the context of the relief efforts:

- Containerized latrines/wash rooms
- Large-size tents of 8x6 and 8x8 meters
- Fire-fighting equipment
- Water bowzers and
- Generators-28 KVA and above

The Prime Minister has appealed to the Pakistani Community to generously contribute in the above fund to help the displaced innocent people.
