**PRESS RELEASE**

Jeddah-August 04, 2010: Pakistan has been severely affected by unprecedented floods caused by heavy rains. It has led to tragic loss of human lives and crops besides widespread loss of livestock, physical/communication infrastructure.

Entire towns and villages have been destroyed leading to displacement of more than two million people.


Already more than 1500 deaths have been reported from affected areas. Nearly 30,000 houses and vast area with standing crops have been destroyed.

The National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) based in the Prime Minister's Secretariat, Islamabad is coordinating the rescue and relief operations.

Pakistani community members, Saudi donors, NGOs and Philanthrops are requested to come forward in this hour of need and help in the relief activity in Pakistan. They may send their donations to the National Disaster Management Fund in the following accounts:
